The National Solid Waste Management Authority (NSWMA) on behalf of the Government of Jamaica (GOJ) hereby invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from local and international companies for utilization of municipal waste generated islandwide.

This project is being implemented by National Solid Waste Management Authority (NSWMA), the executing agency in collaboration Municipal Councils, National Environment & Planning Agency (NEPA) and other state implementing partners. The Authority's regional offices operate eight (8) disposal sites islandwide, namely Riverton, Church Corner, Hadden, Tobalski, Doctor's Wood, Retirement, Myersville and Martin's Hill.

The scope of work envisioned includes, but is not limited to:

- a. setting up and operating facilities with a capacity of more than or equal to 200 Tonnes per day (in a single installation)
- b. Treatment and processing of solid waste (includes conversion to useful output).
- c. Final utilization of the process remnants generated and inert material.

The tonnage of waste available per month at each disposal site for this project are as follows:
